

Fog Lights, Rear and Front

Check conditions:



- Front fog lights: if visibility is substantially reduced by fog, rain, or snow
- Rear fog lights: visibility below 50 meters

Caution: max. speed of 50 km/h

Improper use can result in a fine of 20€

License Plates

Vehicles on public roadways must have valid license plates

Front and rear license plates must be properly mounted on vehicle, and mustbe clearly visible

must not be displayed on dashboard

Failure to comply: Fine of $60 \in +1$ traffic point or criminal complaint for improper display of license plates

Alcohol

- 0.0 per mil
- ⇒ applies to novice drivers and

all drivers below the age of 20 Fine: 250€ and 1 traffic point

0.5—1.09 per mil

 administrative offense
 Fine of 500 €, one month suspesion, and 2 traffic points

exceeding 1.1 per mil

 criminal offense driving under the influence imprisonment or fine

Military authorities will be notified of any of the above offenses!

Controlled Substances

Any use is strictly prohibited!

Peculiarity: German Autobahn

- Multiple lanes of travel
- Often without speed limit: however there is a recommended speed of

130 km/h = recommendation

- <u>km/h</u>, not mph!
- Mandatory to keep in the right lane when possible
- Prohibited to overtake on the right
- Prohibited to operate handheld mobile communication devices

Correct Conduct in Case of an Accident / Breakdown on the Autobahn

- High risk because of high speeds!
- Don't be hasty and drive vehicle to the emergency lane if possible
- Be mindful of the following traffic
- Turn on the hazard lights, then Exit the vehicle and put on a safety vest
- Secure accident location/broken down vehicle, put up warning triangle 150 – 400 meters before vehicle location
- Wait behind guardrail
- Verify the exact location
- Notify police/ambulance/fire department/towing company
- Provide first aid if necessary

Traffic Controls

- General traffic controls, without specific occasion, may occur at any time and in any place
- Comply when instructed by police to stop or follow; non-compliance will result in a fine of 70 Euro

<u>Notice</u>

General rule: if instructed to follow, do so until the next possible parking area or interstate exit

 Keep in mind: there are also unmarked police vehicles

Emergency Vehicles

Police, ambulances, fire/rescue vehicles

- Emergency vehicles with engaged flashing lights and sirens
 - Mandatory for everyone: make way swiftly

Emergency Corridor

Principle: always form an emergency corridor in case of slowing traffic

- Alert other vehicle operators by engaging hazard lights
- Subsequently form emergency corridor
- "Right-hand-rule"
 Emergency corridor always between the outermost left lane and the lanes on the right
- Non-compliance: fine of 200 € and 2 traffic points
